Suggested Treatments*

- 1) Low seeding rate
- 2) Medium seeding rate
- 3) High seeding rate

**Rates will be determined based on target stands, variety & expected survivability*

Trial Design

- Follow a randomized layout
- Minimum four replicates
- Strips need to be at least as wide as one combine pass
- Strips should run the length of the field, excluding the headlands

Your Fields, Your Results

- Established with your equipment
- Under your management practices
- Harvested with your equipment
- MSPG support at establishment & harvest
- MSPG collects data throughout the season
- Results packaged together for you in a short report
- Must be a member in good standing
