

Soybean Seeding Rate Trial

Trial ID: 2022-SSR14 – R.M. of Minitonas-Bowsman

Objective: Quantify the agronomic and economic impacts of different soybean seeding rates.

Summary: The low seeding rate (166,000 seeds/ac) yielded significantly less than the medium seeding rate (196,000 seeds/ac) by a difference of 1.2 bu/ac. The change in profit that resulted from increasing the low seeding rate to the medium seeding rate was economical. The high seeding rate (226,000 seeds/ac) was statistically similar to the yields from the other two seeding rates, yielding 0.7 bu/ac less than the medium seeding rate and 0.5 bu/ac more than the low seeding rate.


